#### **Management Perspective**

Asahi Kasei was founded a century ago, and to manage our business sustainably, as a manager I have always strived to identify things that should be 1) protected and preserved, 2) valued, 3) changed and strengthened, and 4) addressed as new initiatives. As you are assigned to various posts and take up new work, it will be crucial for you to view matters from such perspectives, including consideration of how things have been done to date. It is challenging to change and strengthen, and to take new initiatives. Such actions require courage to take responsibility for results, as well as courage to abandon things when necessary. In times like these, when volatility, uncertainty, complexity, and ambiguity (VUCA) cause dramatic changes in the business environment and nothing is certain, managers need to act with a sense of speed.

"Everything Starts with People" and "Lifelong Growth"

For a company to survive in a rapidly changing environment, it is important for personnel to become a group of specialists and to continue growing. Based on the idea that people are the root of

corporate activities, and in line with the concepts of "everything starts with people" and "lifelong growth," we have created various mechanisms that enable personnel to grow continually. In particular, we are devising a succession of policies and systems that lead to lifelong growth, rather than prioritizing seniority and lifetime employment. If you think of how you can contribute to your company through your own field of expertise and achieve results, a virtuous cycle will arise whereby the company will entrust you with more duties, more people will work with you, and you will have more opportunities to perform management.

#### Passion, Discussion, and Action

The phrases "discussion leads to conclusion" and "passion leads to action" resonate with me. Discussion always leads to direction-setting and helps people to discover something new. Also, the organization as a whole is invigorated by combining together the individual drive and passion of each member. Drawing out drive and passion, forging deeper bonds through discussion with people having diverse perspectives, and connecting this process to concrete action is the basis of our Group Slogan "Creating for Tomorrow."
